Inspirata (“us”, “we”, or “our”) uses cookies on a <http://www.inspirata.com> (the “Service”). By using the Service, you consent to the use of cookies. Our Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third-parties we partner with may use cookies on the Service, your choices regarding cookies and further information about cookies.

Introduction

Inspirata’s goal is to provide a digital experience that is always as intuitive, fast, relevant and as informative as possible. To support in this endeavor, we deploy tracking technologies in the form of both cookies and web beacons/action tags. This cookie notice is designed to provide transparency into the types of technologies we use, together with the reasons why we use them with view to ensure that you are comfortable with the controls you have to protect your privacy.

More Information about Cookies

A cookie is a piece of script that is placed automatically on your computer’s hard drive when you access certain websites that, in serving to identify your unique browser, provide a means to personalize and accelerate the speed of your onsite experience. Web beacons represent script written into the underlying code of the website and are designed to help inform the owner about site performance by recording the instances in which a given action is being undertaken by web visitors, e.g., it might record that you clicked on a video, filled out a form, entered the site via a certain page and left by another, etc.

While there are nuances in how they both work, with cookies and web beacons representing terms frequently used interchangeably, for the purposes of simplification we will refer to both technologies as “cookies” from this point forward.

Why are cookies used?

Cookies assist in different ways, but are typically categorized in the following ways based on the role they fulfil and the value they provide:

- Required Cookies – Used to ensure that the website functions properly. These would be used to ensure any preferences you have expressed in engaging with our site are properly recorded for your next visit.
- Analytics Cookies – Used to measure and analyze digital channel usage by visitors at an aggregate level so as to provide a basis for improving performance.
- Advertising Cookies – Used to enable online advertising, allowing Inspirata to potentially serve adverts when you leave Inspirata.com associated with an explicit or implicit interest you have expressed during your visit(s).
- Social Media Cookies – Used to enable integration of social media into the website, so that you can share or like Inspirata content via your preferred social network.

Third party cookies on the Sites

In some circumstances, we may work with third parties to provide services on our Sites. For example, we use analytics services supported by third party companies who generate analytics cookies on our behalf.

We may not have access to these cookies, although we may use statistical information arising from the cookies provided by these third parties to customize content and for the other purposes described above. These companies may also transfer this information to other parties where required to do so by law, or where such other parties process the information on their behalf. We may not control these third-party cookies and their use may be governed by the privacy policies of the third parties employing these cookies. My choices in relation to cookies

For users originating from the EU, Inspirata affords you the ability to set your cookie preferences by clicking [here](#). You can choose which types of cookies you would like our website to use.

Furthermore, you can change your preferences at any time. You will also find a list of all cookies within each category—required, analytics, social media and advertising—so as to make an informed call as which you are happy to accept. Note that using the cookie settings may not result in the removal of any cookies that have already been set. However, this can be easily performed via your web browser settings after you have changed your cookie settings on Inspirata.com.

Managing or Disabling Cookies at the Browser

If you simply disable all cookies, you may experience issues with certain elements of our web experience as your browser may prohibit us setting functionality required cookies. Required Cookies

Required cookies are used to ensure a functional site experience. They are used at Inspirata.com in the following ways:

- Storing preferences such as language, location, the number of search results to be displayed, etc.
- Storing settings for optimal video display, such as buffer size and your screen's resolution details
- Reading your browser settings so that we can display our website optimally on your screen
- Loading the website evenly so that it remains accessible
- Optimizing our website in real time depending on how you use the website, e.g. by making a field in a form blink after a period of inactivity

Analytics Cookies

Analytics cookies are used to measure website usage and might be in the form of:

- Recording the number of visitors to our web pages
- Keeping track of the length of time that each visitor spends on our web pages
- Determining the order in which a visitor visits the various pages on our website
- Assessing which parts of our site need to be improved
- Optimizing the website

Social Media Cookies

Cookies for sharing website content via social media enable users of selected social media to share and like certain content directly from Inspirata.com.

Advertising Cookies
